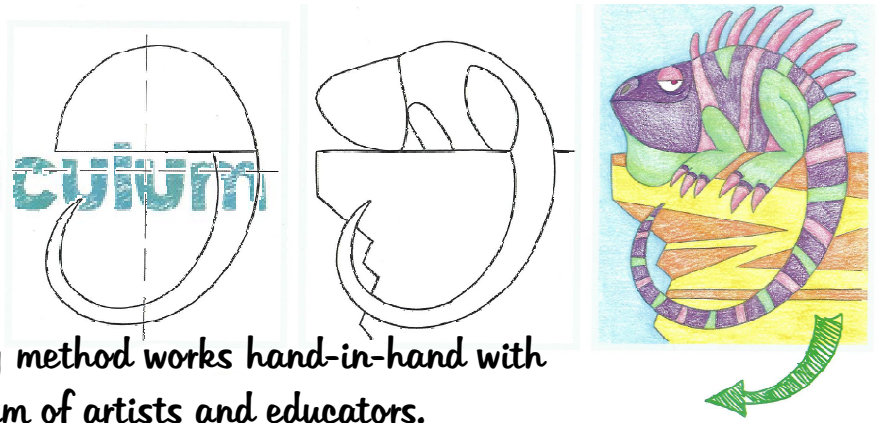


Elementary drawing curriculum

Cost: \$120.00 *Limited to 18 students

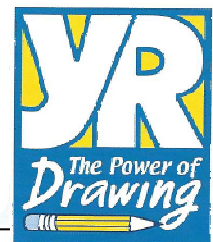

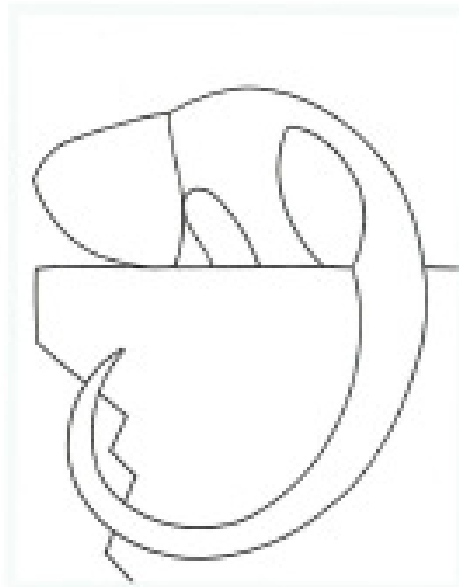
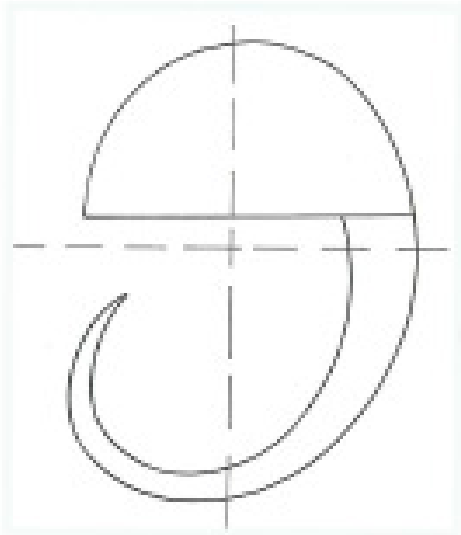
